I am full Professor of Endocrinology at Lyon1 University, France, head of the endocrine department at Lyon University Hospital and in-charge of the Reference Center of Rare Pituitary Disease of Lyon.

I lead a research team dedicated to “Pathophysiology of pituitary tumour” at the INSERM Research Center U1052.

My major research interests are pituitary tumour pathogenesis and identification of markers of aggressiveness allowing the identification of potential new therapies with a special focus on aggressive pituitary tumours and carcinomas.

I am member of ENEA since 2009 and component of the ENEA Workshop & Study Committee since 2017. I will host the 2022 ENEA congress in Lyon.
